

NC Wild Ginseng Landowner Written Permission (Printable)

To collect ginseng from another's land, the collector must have written permission from the landowner, dated and valid for no longer than 180 days. The document must be on the collector's person when digging ginseng on that land. This requirement applies to both public and private lands. In National Forests, district offices are responsible for such permits. State and National Parks, including the Blue Ridge Parkway and the Great Smoky Mountain National Parks, do not allow ginseng collection.
